

Professor Krzysztof Jan Kurzydłowski
Director National Centre for Research and Development (NCRD)



Professor Krzysztof Jan Kurzydłowski is a graduate of the Faculty of Technical Physics and Applied Mathematics of the Warsaw University of Technology. He obtained a PhD degree from the Faculty of Materials Science and Engineering of the Warsaw University of Technology and D. Sc. from the Technical University of Silesia. His research interests include the design of nano-materials. He has published over 400 papers in refereed journals and supervised over 50 PhD students. Over the past 10 years, Professor Kurzydłowski has held numerous positions in public science administration, including as Under-Secretary of State for Science and Higher Education (2006-2007). On 20 December 2010 Professor Kurzydłowski was appointed Director of the National Centre for Research and Development (NCRD) – a research funding agency with an annual budget of over 1 billion euro.
